

# Meeting the requirements of V1

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## Learning Objectives

- To aid recognition of the key functions that Internal Verifiers must perform to enable them to fully meet V1 requirements
- Identification of evidence requirements (linking to the V1 standard) and assessment strategy requirements for V1. Clarification of any grey areas.
- Recognition of the key organisational changes that may be necessary to enable the achievement of the V1 standard.
- Identification of factors that promote best practice in verification.
